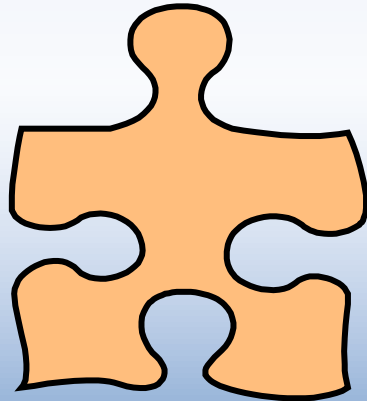
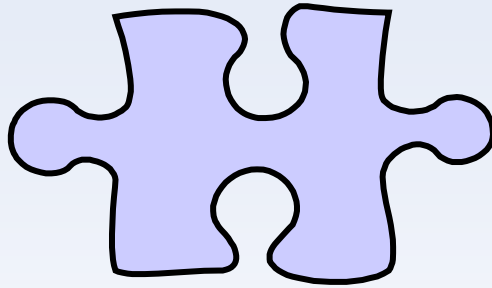
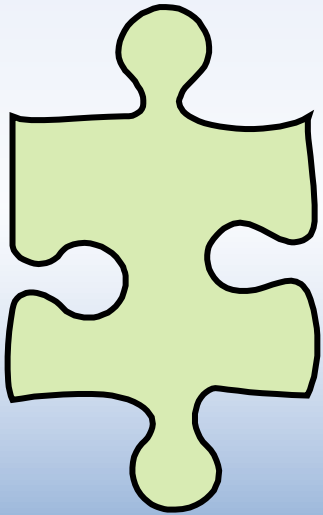

# The Starting Point

## Shared vision

- ✓ All countries have the knowledge and capacity to design, manage and monitor policies and interventions to achieve their education goals

## Clear objectives

- ✓ Strengthen capacity to develop and effectively implement good education policies
- ✓ Support countries to address thematic challenges
- ✓ Reinforce the role of the LEG in coordinating support to the education sector

➤ **EFA FTI Mid-Term Evaluation** suggests to focus on:

- ✓ Comprehensive strategies
- ✓ Longer-term, strategic support
- ✓ Plan implementation
- ✓ Country ownership

➤ **The new FTI Single Fund** implies:

- ✓ One source of funding for all activities
- ✓ One process to access funds

➤ **The new M&E Strategy** implies:

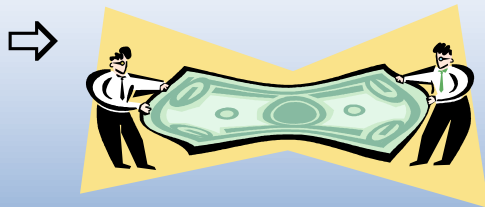
- ✓ One M&E Framework
- ✓ One Accountability Matrix

# Key Operational Considerations

- ⇒ Integrating PACE into Secretariat's work and key FTI processes
- ⇒ Reconciling separate PACE funding with a single fund approach
- ⇒ Promoting longer-term, more strategic and sustainable CD
- ⇒ Streamlining FTI governance structures to achieve one process for FTI decision-making

# Key Operational Considerations

- ⇒ Seeking out and leveraging FTI partner's comparative advantages
- ⇒ Building linkages with partner countries' institutions for delivering CD
- ⇒ Being clear about the role of the Secretariat
- ⇒ Being realistic about additional staff

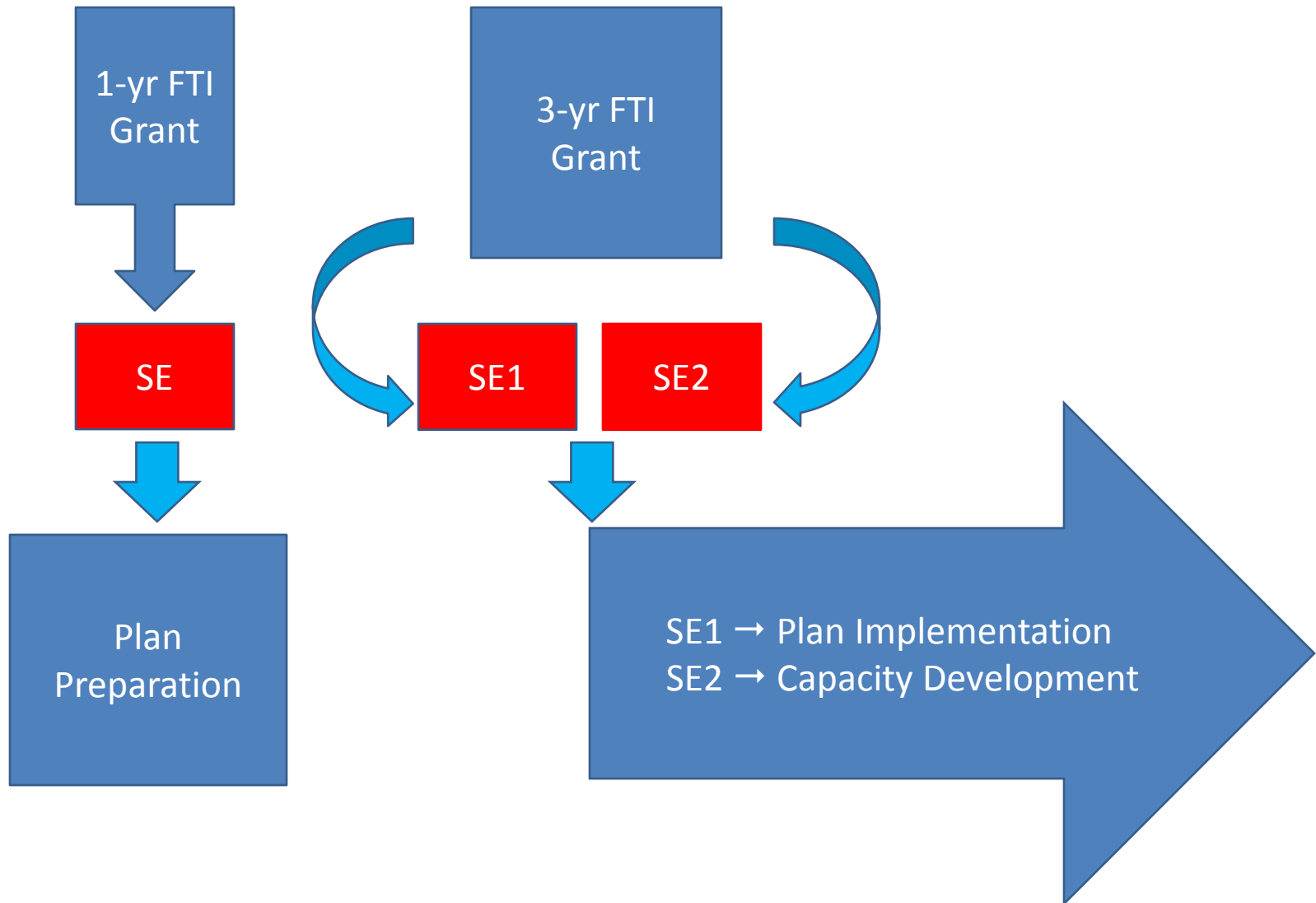
