

## **2024 IN NUMBERS**

Data from GPE Secretariat/Results Report 2024 December 2024

2 COUNTRIES joined GPE: Jordan and Lebanon. GPE now supports 90 partner countries.

GPE has reached 253 MILLION children since 2021-70% live in partner countries affected by fragility and conflict.

## In FY24:

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- Partner countries distributed **46 MILLION textbooks**, trained over 465,000 teachers and built/renovated over 15,000 classrooms.
- 87% of grants included at least 1 activity on gender equality; <u>ė ě</u> close to 90% of partner countries include priority reforms informed by gender analysis, data and evidence. Genderfocused grants reached \$1.3 BILLION.
  - 77 grants supported learning assessments in 65 partner countries.
- 70 partner countries since 2021 have used GPE Knowledge ê ê and Innovation Exchange (KIX) evidence in 240 cases to inform policy development.



Civil society organizations supported by Education Out Loud have influenced education planning, policy dialogue and monitoring in **48 partner countries** since 2021.

100% of technical assistance initiatives for climate-smart education, gender equality, safe learning, school nutrition and Tech4Ed are on track.



## 5 out of 10 YOUNG CHILDREN have access to pre-primary education in partner countries, preparing them to learn in later years.

7 out of 10 CHILDREN are completing ្ត្តឺក្តិត្តឹក្តិ 🔪 primary school and 6 out of 10 children complete lower-secondary education in partner countries.



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97% of local education groups in partner countries include civil society representatives; 64% include teacher representatives.

80% of pre-primary and 86% of primary teachers are qualified.

GPE reached \$3.8 BILLION in education financing raised from 64 cofinanciers through its innovative financing tool, the GPE Multipliermore than double the target for 2024.

- Close to **60% of partner countries** either maintained their education spending at or above 20% or increased it-the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 64% of GPE grants are harmonized with other external financing.
